Background History

In brief, I would like to write about my father. So I have looked for a suitable font-set in the market. I then have learnt that none of the commercial Assamese, Bengali, or Manipuri font-sets is complete to support all Kamrupi phonemes and *juktyakshar*. So I have decided to design a font-set to solve the purpose. The idea was good as I can improve the font-set to an extent before I complete the manuscript on my Father.

Initially, I call the font-set *Asomi Ratne* but later on changed to *Aadarsha Ratne*. This is done as because it brings the font-set to the top of the menu by any word-processor utility. The other name *Ratne* is in dedication to our beloved father, as his friends used to call him *Ratne*.

Aadarsha Ratne script-set turns out to be the World's first 32-bit TrueType supporting all *juktkshyar*. The script-set supports languages as such Assamese, Bengali, Kamrupi and Manipuri. The script-set is designed using rather complex-conjugate vector technique and due to its algorithmic design concept although the font-set is 32-bit it takes less then 50k disk-space. Version 1.01 was available in February 1999, and it was installed in AGP office, Guwahati Club Ambari, in April 1999. There has



been a number of changes since then and Version 2.01 was released in June 1999. There are some default mapping differences between 1.01 and 2.01, but it does not affect the users. A major version is now available to support all type of professional writing with default mapping same as 2.01, i.e., default mapping remains the same from verson 2.01 on words.

Ratne font-set has been found well received in Assam and abroad. People have started using it for writing e-mails around the world. Some of World's first Assamese e-mails are in link http://ratneresearch.com/. Academic and research institutes have also started using *Aadarsha Ratne* font-set, including Tezpur University and Plasma Research Institute of Assam, India. URL http://ratneresearch.com/ includes more information on *Ratne scripts* including answers to FAQ and other related information.

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Installation Instruction

Requires IBM PC/AT, Microsoft Windows 3.0/3.1, Windos95/98/2000, Windows NT, Windows XP etc, with 100KB HD space and any Window Word-processor - also works for MAC Unix and Linux.

If you have an old version of same Aadarsha Ratne font then first uninstall the old font file before installing the new version.

Setup Instruction for Windows 3.0/3.1

At DOS Prompt type "win" or run Windows. In Windows Main Group then double click on Control Panel; insert the font disk in your 3 and 1/2 inch floppy drive; from Control Panel Windows, double click on "Fonts"; fonts window, click on Add box; change Drives to where the font disk you had inserted; choose *Aadarsha Ratne* and double click. Installation is done. Close Control Panel windows; re-boot the PC

Setup Instruction for Windows 95/98/2000 and NT/WinXP

Open the "Font" folder in the PC (click on "My Computer" then click on "Control Panel" then click on "Font") then place uncompressed font file to "Font" folder.

Setup Instruction for MAC

Place uncompressed font file on Desktop and click it. A window will appear with installation button; click on this button. Or simply place the font file into the "Font Book" folder in MAC or to "/user/library/Fonts" folder.

Setup Instruction for Linux

- 1. Create a directory for new fonts # mkdir /usr/share/fonts/truetype
- 3. Navigate to the font directory # cd /usr/share/fonts/truetype
- 5. Add the new font directory to the X11 font path # chkfontpath --add /usr/share/fonts/truetype
- 2. Move the uncompressed font files to the new font directory # mv *.ttf /usr/share/fonts/truetype
- 4. Create fonts.scale and fonts.dir
 # mkfontscale && mkfontdir
 # fc-cache
- Restart X font server # /etc/rc.d/init.d/xfs restart

How to Use

Ratne font-set can be used in any window application such as Microsoft Words, Lotus AmiPro, Microsoft Excel, Lotus 123, Visio, WordPerfect, Microsoft Write, Microsoft Works, Microsoft Powerpoint, PrintShop for Windows, AutoCad for windows, Canvas for Windows, Paintbrush for windows etc. In order to use, run any window version above or Microsoft Word. Select * Ratne * font from fonts pull-down menu and enjoy.

Ratne Class I Algorithm

This algorithm is a method that its implementation enables one to restore *Romanized Assamese* typing-habits while still viewing *Ratne screepts* on screen in the computer. In brief it is a macro rule-base with artificial intelligence, i.e., the user will either be corrected or asked to choose a *Romanized Assamese* word to tune her/him to her/his typing-habits. This technique is right now under experimentation and yet to be released to users, but this is a platform independent utility.

While "Ratne Class II Mapping Algorithm" is described here, you may implement any or both algorithms for your use if you have a license for the font-set or get a license as well as copy of the Macro-utility from *Ratne Research*.

Ratne Class II Composite and Juktyakshar Mapping

Open a Microsoft Word document and set the font set to *Ratne Internet* in the fonts' pull down menu. In the table below, first column from left is a number-sequence. On your keyboard both left and right side of the space bar there are two keys "Alt". Press a "Alt" key, while pressing punch the number from the number pad located on the right hand side of your keyboard; the Num Lock key must be turned on.



Ratne Microsoft Mapping


The second column of *Ratne Class II Mapping* that starts with "Ctrl+" is what is called *Ratne Microsoft Mapping*. If you have remembered the basic *Ratne Class II Number & Punctuation Mapping* and *Ratne Class II Alphabet Mapping* then it should be easy to remember the "Ctrl+" sequences.

To create the macro-utility, open a Microsoft Word document and give it a suitable name.



Now from the pull-down menu choose *Ratne* font. Then choose "Insert" from the menu bar, and from the pull-down menu choose "symbol". It will display the "Symbol" image in your Microsoft Word doc. If you do not see *Ratne* font then click on the arrow in the font window and choose *Ratne* font as applicable.

You may highlight any akhar juktyakshar or symbal here using the Blue Cursor and you can move it to different location either by using the mouse or by arrow keys. Then you click on "Shortcut Key..." button to enable you to map the akhar juktyakshar or symbol that you have highlighted (make sure that you remove any previous assignment before you assign any short-cut keys). For Ratne font-set I would recommend you to use Ratne Microsoft Mapping that I defined in tables above; it will make it easy for you to remember. You can also create your own Ratne Microsoft Mapping as you wish.
